

NOT DUN YET BARREL RACE SHOW RULES AND FORMAT

WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY AT THE ARENA DIRECTORS' DISCRETION

1. All contestants must check into show office before running.
2. There will be a \$25 charge for all NSF checks plus bank charges on all return checks.
3. No refunds without a medical release or a vet slip if a medical issue arises day of show a release may be issued by directors discretion.
4. Dress code will be enforced. Western long sleeve shirts show attire is ok. No scoop neck or t-shirts allowed. Appropriate footwear with heel must be worn if on horseback at any time.
5. You will receive 3 gate calls - after that the contestant will be disqualified.
6. An electric timer will be used for all runs. Should timer fail to function a rerun will be granted at the end of the draw.
7. There will be no rerun given if a horse falls.
8. Knocking over a barrel during a race will result in a no time.
9. Contestants cannot change horses during an event.
10. Horses name must be given to show officials before you compete. If you are running multiple horses the names must be on entry forms before the draw. You must run each horse in proper draw order.
11. All racers must enter through the same gate and exit through the same gate.
12. Once a racer completes a run she may not re-cross the start line either between the two electric eyes or the start line extended to both arena fences.
13. Racers may go to either the right or left barrel first, but must make two left turns
14. and one right turn or two right turns and one left.
15. No excessive jockeying of horses or circling after entering the arena. Racer must proceed through the gate in a forward motion to position, turn and go, or one 360 degree turn is permitted. Otherwise racer is disqualified.
16. Failure to follow a course disqualifies a contestant.
17. A racer must enter the arena mounted on horse.
18. Late entries will be accepted until 1 hour prior to race with a \$10 late fee and added to the end of the draw.
19. We are very lucky to have use of Patrick's arena. Please be respectful and use garbage receptacles.
20. The arena director will settle any questions or disputes that may arise during the show that are not covered by the above rules.

Format

Paybacks will be as follows:

- Open 80% on entry fees,
- Youth 80% on entry fees.
- 100% payback on all added money.

The awards will be given on the following open division splits

- 1D Fastest Time
- 2D 0.5 Seconds
- 3D 1.0 Seconds
- 4D 1.5 Seconds

Youth

- 1D Fastest Time
- 2D 1.0 Seconds

The same horse must be ridden once the race starts.

Knocked over barrels will receive a no time.

Contestants may be paid go around money on more than one horse in each division.

We will rake every 5 barrel racers and full grounds work every 50 barrel racers.

Disputes and Questions:

- Arena directors will be the first one that is approached during the barrel race when you have a complaint and/or questions or concerns.
- Do not approach the director while they are on their horses, they are competing as everyone else and deserve the same time to prepare for their runs as any other rider.

All peewees pre-entered will receive their special awards.

Open 4 awards will be given in all 4D's to the top 4 in each D. All 16 placing will be eligible for the open saddle in a fun drawing.

Youth 3 awards will be given in both 2D's to the top 3 in each D. All 6 placing will be eligible for the youth saddle in a fun drawing.

Awards will be 1 hour following the last racer. PDIA will be holding a Spaghetti Feed dinner to raise funds for the upcoming season's events. All winners must be present and in full dress code and available for pictures to receive awards.
